

# The Hook Stroke

Correct footwork is all important
THE right foot is moving well back bringing the
body to the off side just inside the line of the oncoming ball.

The bat has been lifted mainly by the bottom hand, the back foot points towards midoff. Body is opened by the back foot as it moves back. The head is kept as still as possible.

The ball is rising high off the pitch. The body is erect, bat is brought down and well forward across the body. Correct footwork has allowed
