

A Melbourne boat won the Southern 80 speed boat race last Sunday on the Murray River. Crowds lined the bank of the river to see the boat 'Violator' driven by Barry Tudor race to a new record at the Moama Water Sports Club 80 kilometre Ski Trial from Torrumbarry to Echuca. The boat took over one minute off the previous record held by 'Harada', a local boat. 'Violator's' time was 40.33.43 minutes.
